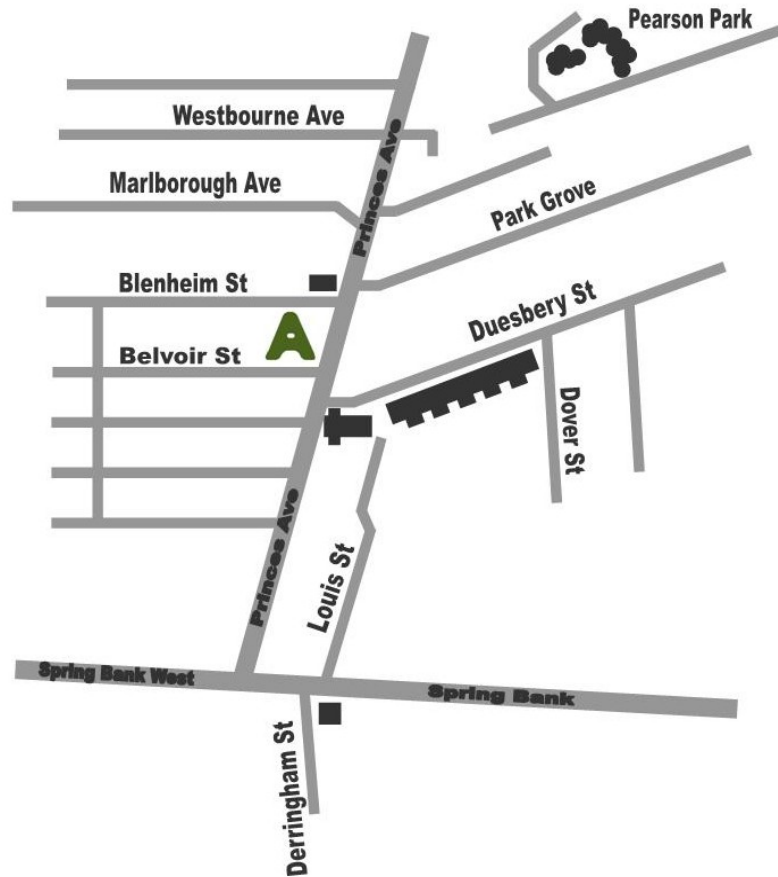

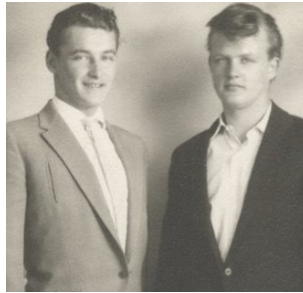
Suited & Booted

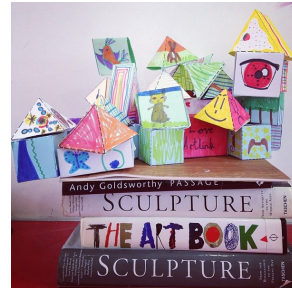


Summer Art School
